### 2022 CHRISTMAS PARADE GUIDELINES

#### Please read carefully and distribute to each participant/parent in your group!

- \* The parade will begin at the Chamber of Commerce, continue down Broad Street, and end at First United Methodist Church.
- All units <u>MUST</u> be decorated in the parade theme Merry Melodies of Christmas. Entries may be historical, humorous, religious, or modern in design, as long as they are in good taste. Remember – a large part of the audience will be children.
- \* **NO SANTA IMPERSONATORS ARE ALLOWED!** Santa will be escorted in by the Cairo Fire Department.
- \* Parade entries must be lit and fully decorated for Christmas. This is a nighttime Christmas parade. You will need to be sure there is adequate lighting for your entry. Any entry not lit or decorated will be removed from the parade. No exceptions. Please note that only a limited number of vehicles will be accepted.
- \* For the safety of all, <u>NO ITEMS MAY BE THROWN FROM A MOVING ENTRY!</u> This includes candy, flyers, literature, food, etc.
- \* Judges will evaluate the entry's interpretation of the parade theme. All entries being judged must be in place no later than 5:45pm. Judging will begin promptly at 6pm.
- \* Entries not being judged must be lined up by 6:30pm.
- \* <u>No hot-rodding or wheelies will be allowed during the parade</u>. This will be strictly enforced to ensure the safety of all spectators.
- \* All motorized vehicles, except for antique vehicles, must be decorated in the holiday spirit and support the parade theme.
- \* All units MUST display the name/sponsor of their entry.
- \* All groups using animals of any type in the parade are required to have a clean-up crew following the unit. Participants will be responsible for cleaning up after their animals in the staging and disembarked areas.
- \* Currently serving elected officials may be invited to ride in the parade. They may not campaign for re-election, nor may they display any electioneering materials in the parade.
- Parade information (entry number, staging instructions & official times) will be emailed to the email address noted on the parade application prior to the parade. All entries <u>MUST</u> have a completed parade package on file at the Chamber of Commerce.
- \* The parade will move at a walking pace. <u>No stopping during the parade</u>. Any entry having difficulty should move out of the parade route. The Chamber of Commerce is NOT responsible for children getting on or off floats. Please make sure arrangements are made for children to be picked up by a responsible adult at the end of the parade.
- \* The parade will end at First United Methodist Church. Please remember to pull as far away from Broad Street as possible to disassemble.
