2025 Cairo Christmas Parade Guidelines

Please read carefully & distribute to all parade participants.

Parade Theme & Entry Requirements

- All entries must be decorated with the parade theme: "A Storybook Christmas." Entries may be historical, humorous, religious, or modern in design, but must be in good taste, as many spectators will be children.
- All entries must be lit and fully decorated in the holiday spirit to support the parade theme. This is a nighttime parade entries without lights or decorations are subject to removal from the parade.
- No Santa impersonators are allowed. Santa will be featured at the end of the parade and escorted by the Cairo Fire Department.
- Parade entry signs (11x14) must be placed in the front left windshield of each vehicle. Signs will be available
 for pickup from the Chamber during the week of the parade and must be picked up before 3:00pm on
 Wednesday, December 3rd.

Parade Route, Lineup, & Judging Details

- The parade will begin at the Chamber of Commerce, continue down Broad Street, and end at Cairo First Methodist Church.
- Parade entries may begin dropping off floats at their assigned space starting at 3:00pm. The lineup order will be emailed to the address provided on your entry form at the beginning of parade week.
- Streets near the lineup area will be blocked off at 4:00pm. After that time, only official parade entries will be allowed to enter the lineup area.
- The Chamber will provide shuttles at designated areas to transport participants to their floats. Participants must provide the name or number of their entry to ensure drop-off at the correct location.
- All entries interested in being judged must be completed and in place by 5:30pm. Judging will begin promptly
 at 5:45pm. Due to time constraints, the judges will only make one attempt to judge each entry. Judges will
 evaluate entries based on their interpretation of the parade theme. All entries not choosing to be judged must
 be lined up by 6:30pm.

Parade Conduct, Safety, & End-of-Route Procedures

- For the safety of all participants and spectators, no items may be thrown from moving entries. This includes candy, flyers, literature, food, or other materials.
- Hot-rodding, burnouts, or wheelies are strictly prohibited at any point during the parade. These rules will be strictly enforced to protect spectators and other participants.
- The parade will move at a steady walking pace with no stopping permitted. If your entry experiences difficulties, please exit the parade route promptly and safely.
- Entries using animals of any kind must have a clean-up crew following the unit. All participants are responsible for maintaining cleanliness in both the staging and unloading areas.
- Currently serving elected officials may be permitted to ride in the parade but may not campaign or display election-related materials.
- All entries must have a completed parade package on file at the Chamber. Final instructions, entry numbers, and lineup details will be emailed to the address listed on the application.
- At the conclusion of the parade at Cairo First Methodist Church, please ensure all children are picked up by a
 responsible adult. The Chamber is not responsible for children exiting floats. The Cairo Police Department
 will be directing traffic in the unloading area—please follow their instructions for a safe and orderly exit from
 the parade route.

Acknowledgement of Parade Guidelines
